### Electronics - Cell Phones - Batteries

All equipment will be broken down by Premier Surplus and processed so it can be re-used, thus lessening demands on local landfills and keeping toxins from leaking into our soil and waterways! All collections will be done free of charge, except for TV's which require a fee of \$25. Projection TV's \$40. CRT Monitors \$10 and LCD Monitors with a Broken Screen \$5. No credit/debit cards or checks. Cell phones will be collected for the Georgia Lions Lighthouse. Please place a piece of clear tape over the terminals of the batteries prior to drop off.

### Compact Fluorescent Light Bulbs - Hearing Aids - Eyeglasses - Magazine/Newspaper

Light bulbs must be in a clear plastic, sealed bag. No long, tubular style fluorescent light bulbs. Home Depot stores will accept compact fluorescent light bulbs all year long!
