

Subject: Limit on # of Cases Heard by Planning Commission

WHEREAS, The Mayor and Council of the City of Woodstock, Georgia desire to give each and every petitioner a fair and honest review of their request; and

WHEREAS, They, as well as the Planning Commission, must have adequate time to read and absorb the numerous documents, comments and other information that goes with a petitioners request for annexation, rezoning or variance; and

WHEREAS, In order to achieve this goal, it is necessary to limit the number of requests that come before the Council and their review boards to assure that every petitioner receives due process.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT, The Mayor and Council of the City of Woodstock, Georgia, do hereby limit the number of new petitions/applications that can be brought before the Planning Commission to (4) four on any one regular meeting night.
